What is the Learning Hub?

The Learning Hub is a central store where you can access school resources and information about what is going on at school.

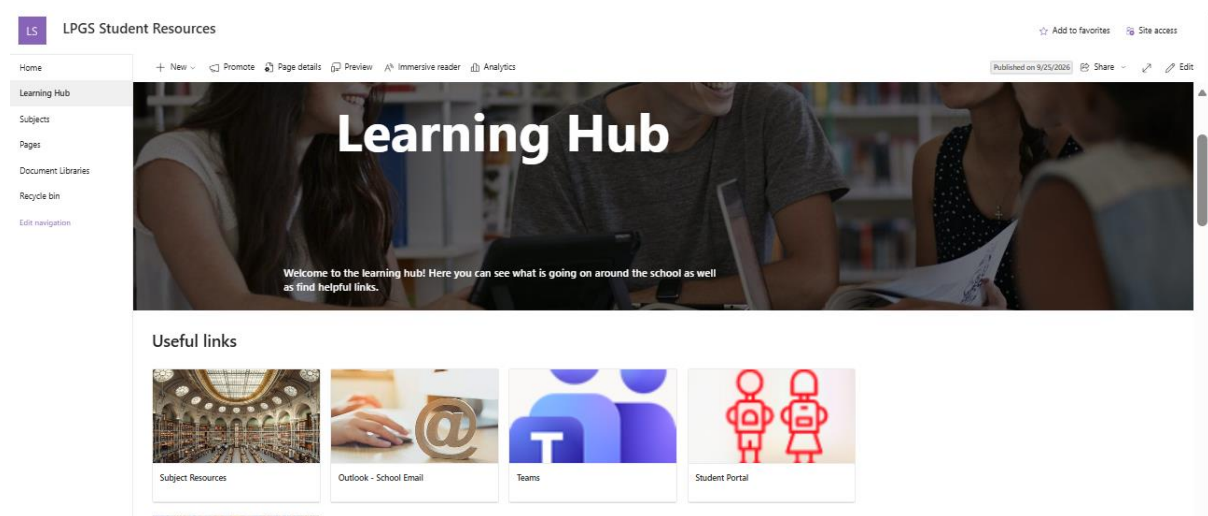
What devices can access it?

The Learning Hub can be accessed on a range of devices, making it convenient for students to use both in school and at home:

- Desktop computers – Access through a web browser at school or home.
- Laptops – Full access via an internet browser.
- Tablets – Compatible with most modern tablets using a web browser.
- Smartphones – Accessible on iOS and Android devices through a mobile browser.

This flexibility allows students to find resources anytime, anywhere with an internet connection.

What does it look like?



It is a website page with links to various resources.

Subject Resources: These are files related to your subjects that teachers can share with you.

Outlook: This is a link to your email

Teams: Used by some teachers to send you resources.

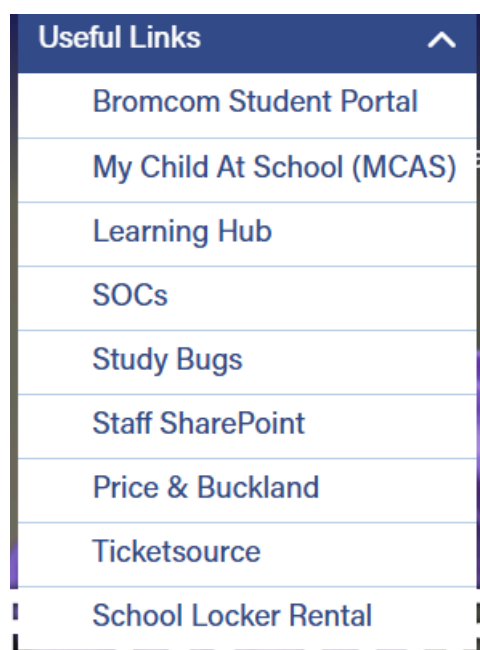
Student Portal: A link to the Bromcom student portal
