





# Our Key Stage 5 Offer



All students study 3 – 4 A-levels or equivalent vocational qualifications as part of their full-time programme of study.



### Langley Park Ensuring the Best Course for Success

Students have until **Friday 19th September** to make changes to programme of study.

They will then sit a baseline assessment from Monday 22nd Sept to Tuesday 30th Sept to confirm course suitability.

Students must get a form from the common room in the sixth form base and complete <u>all</u> information on the form including parental consent (changes will not be processed without this). Students must carry on going to their timetabled lessons until they are advised of changes, as it will have a negative effect on their attendance.

Successful changes will be dependent on class capacity (if any) the timetable blocking and you meeting the subject entry requirements.

## **Guided Learning**

### What is Guided Learning?

All Sixth Form students have **compulsory** supervised study on their timetables.

It is part of their programme of study.

It is included in overall attendance figures.

- Teaches independent study skills
- Work is set at the start of each term by subject teachers
- Builds on lessons and develops deeper understanding
- Gives students' an opportunity to practice higher level independent learning skills

# Wellbeing Tiers of Support

### **Universal Support**

All students supported by form tutors and teachers to deal with day-to-day issues.

All have access to PSHCE, assemblies and form time curriculum to support students to take proactive steps to support their wellbeing

### **Low Level Support**

Low level anxiety; low mood; friendship issues; low levels of self-esteem

Form Tutors, Buddy System, Peer Mentoring, Assistant HOY, Bromley \ Support Call



### **Medium Level Support**

Superficial self-harm; anxiety which becomes a barrier to education; emotional based school avoidance; family breakdown

HOY, Academic Mentor, Bromley Y referral



### **High Level Support**

Anxiety which is preventing access to education; isolation; significant friendship issues; trauma; some issues with eating/body image; self-harming behaviours; OCD behaviours

HKS, Pastoral Managers, Safeguarding Team, SEND, Mentoring, EWO



### **High Level Risk**

Complex trauma; increased levels and risk associated with self-harm; suicidal ideation and planning; thoughts of harming others; eating issues; severe OCD

Counselling, BCP, CAMHS

- Students with attendance below 90% achieve <u>almost</u> half a grade on average below what is expected
