Welcome back! I hope everyone had a restful and enjoyable half-term break. It's been wonderful to see the school buzzing with energy again as we enter the final half-term of the academic year.

This week has already seen some enrichment opportunities taking place. Our students with English as an additional language enjoyed a fascinating visit to Hampton Court Palace, exploring history and culture in a truly immersive setting. Meanwhile, our Year 10 Drama students took part in a thought-provoking trip to the Bethlem Museum of the Mind to develop their understanding of mental health and support their knowledge and understanding of the GCSE set play 'Find Me.'

We are also pleased to report that our first Year 7 teaching groups have taken part in Minds Up workshops, delivered by representatives from South East London Mind. These sessions are designed to raise awareness of mental health, helping our young people to recognise the signs of poor mental health and empowering them to take positive action.

Today marks a significant transition for our Year 11 students, as we have now suspended the normal lesson timetable. As previously communicated, students in Year 11 are now expected to attend school only for their examinations and scheduled revision sessions. We wish them and our current Year 13 students the very best as they continue their exam journey this month.

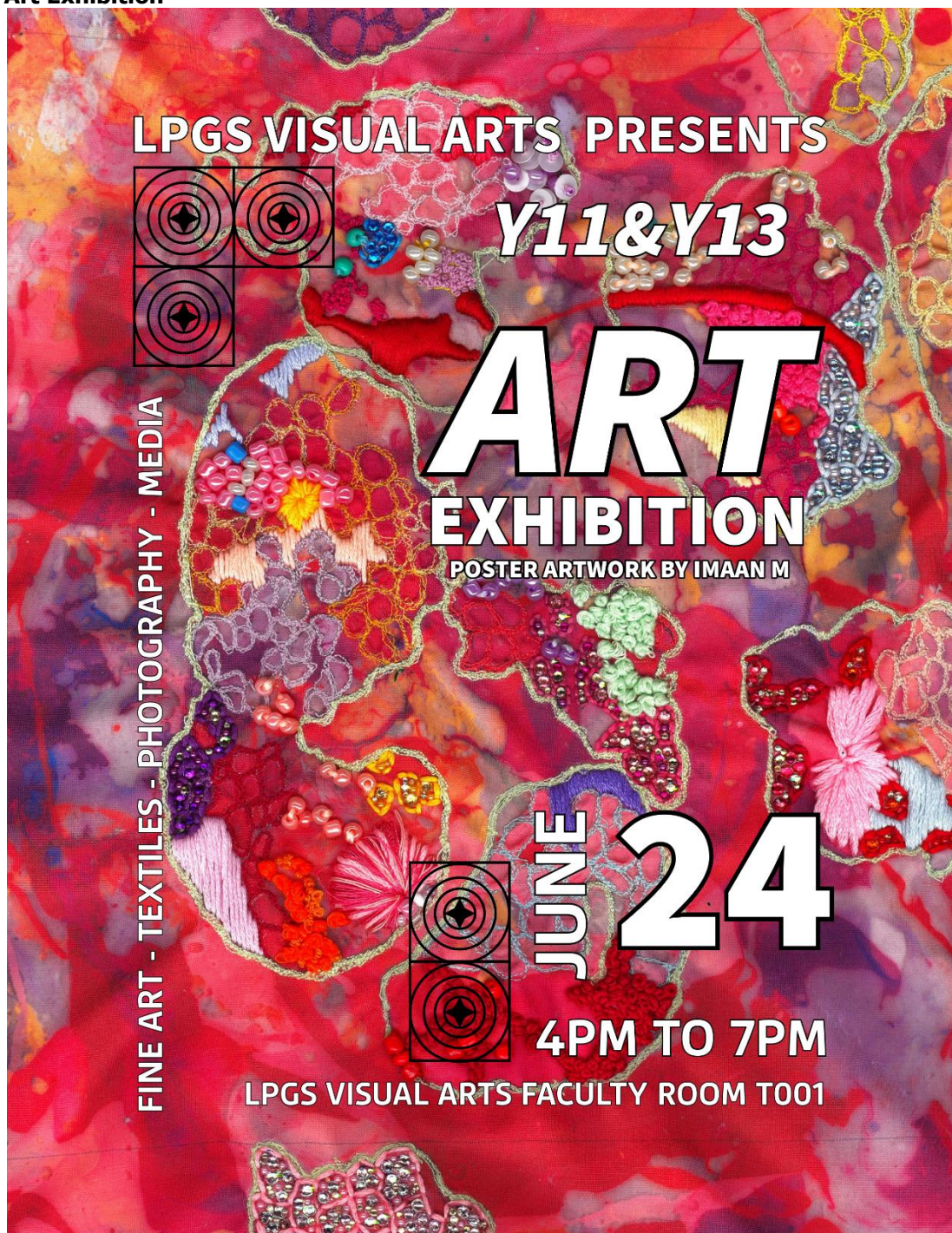
National Thank A Teacher Day – 18 June 2025
