Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: Personal Development Day & Open Evening – Thursday 2 October 2025

As part of our ongoing commitment to developing a sense of 'belonging' and enabling everyone to thrive, we are looking to once again run a Personal Development Day on Thursday 2 October. Feedback from students and staff last year was that this provided a really valuable opportunity for every students to have a 1:1 conversation, to reflect on and share their interests and successes, setting personal goals for the year.

On this day normal lessons will be suspended and students will complete remote learning from home independently as well as attending school during this time for an individual appointment with their form tutor or another allocated member of staff. Shortly, students in all year groups (Years 7-13) will be advised of a time and location for their 1:1 appointment with a member of staff; for the majority of our students, this will be with their form tutor.

Students are expected to attend school in correct school uniform/Sixth Form dress code. During their time in school, students will complete a self-reflection and prepare for an individual appointment with a member of staff lasting approximately 10 minutes. They will be encouraged to reflect on their achievements to date, their goals (considering academic, pastoral and enrichment aspects of school life) and to set targets for the remainder of this academic year. Alongside these targets, they will also be asked to consider what further support they may need from the school or home, which we will communicate to you subsequently. Students will be in school for approximately 30-40 minutes on this day.

Students will be required to report to a designated area for their year group on arrival at school. Following their appointment, they will be free to sign out, to leave school and to return home and resume remote learning.

Any student who does not attend their appointment on that day will need to complete their appointment at another time, likely to be after school, and their absence from school will be recorded as unauthorised unless there is a justifiable reason.

We are planning a series of worthwhile activities for students to complete from home on this day, in support of their personal development, including a focus on wellbeing. Years 11 and 13 are encouraged to use the time at home as an opportunity for revision and consolidation in preparation for their forthcoming trial exams, however they should also build in time to focus on their wellbeing.

An opportunity will be built in for a mid-year reflection for students to reflect on their progress in achieving the targets they have set for themselves, as well as another opportunity towards the end of the year to reflect further.

If your child is entitled to receive free school meals, you can request a packed lunch from school by completing this form. Lunches will be available for collection by your child from the Canteen during the morning.

If you cannot make alternative arrangements for your child to work from home during the day, we will have limited capacity within school to accommodate children and provide supervision for the completion of online remote learning tasks. Please complete this form **by Friday 26 September.**

We hope that all students will see the day as a positive opportunity for them to reflect on their learning, progress and achievements while also identifying ways in which they want to develop and improve. We very much look forward to speaking with students on an individual basis and to continuing to support them in school.

As ever, we recognise that there will be a large number of student volunteers supporting the event and many students will therefore be returning into school in the evening to support as tour guides and within department areas.
