Dear Parent/Carer,

We hope your child has shared some of the key information from the recent TfL workshop on Sexual Harassment. As promised, please find below a summary of the session:

Key Points Covered

Types of Sexual Harassment:

- Non-physical: catcalling, inappropriate questioning
- Physical: following, flashing, upskirting, frottage (rubbing/pressing)
- Technological: cyberflashing

Responses to Sexual Harassment:

Fight, Flight, Freeze, Friend

Active Bystander Strategies:

- Supporting the target
- Reporting the incident
- Remembering key details

How to Report Sexual Harassment:

- British Transport Police (BTP) website
- Text **61016**
- Crimestoppers
- Call 999

Students were advised to seek help from a *safer stranger* such as someone in uniform at their place of work (e.g., a bus driver). They should use clear language, as staff have received specific training to respond appropriately.

Why Reporting Matters:

Only 10% of cases are reported; reporting helps TfL and the police identify patterns, take preventive measures, and catch offenders.

Feedback on the Session

The workshop was an excellent learning experience. The facilitators were highly knowledgeable and handled this very sensitive topic in an engaging and informative way, ensuring students felt comfortable and empowered to discuss these issues.
