As we move further into the summer term, it has been another busy and rewarding week here at Langley. I am delighted to share some of the highlights and updates from across the school community.

Students with English as an Additional Language enjoyed a fantastic cultural trip to London on Tuesday. They visited the National Gallery, explored the vibrant Southbank, and experienced the history and architecture of Westminster Abbey. Meanwhile a group of Year 10 students attended a STEM-focused trip to the University of Greenwich, where they took part in activities designed to develop their problem-solving and communication skills. The day also provided valuable insight into potential careers in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics. Experiences like this play an important role in inspiring future pathways.

Thank you to all the parents and carers who joined us for the Year 12 Parents' Evening this week. It was a valuable opportunity to reflect on progress, discuss next steps, and ensure that students are well supported as they move towards their final year of Sixth Form. The strong partnership between home and school is key to student success, and we greatly appreciate your engagement.

This week we said goodbye to the second group of trainee teachers who have been working with us this academic year. They have made a significant contribution to lessons and to the wider life of the school, bringing enthusiasm, fresh ideas and commitment. We thank them sincerely and wish them every success as they embark on their teaching careers.

Our Year 11 and Year 13 students are nearing the end of their GCSE and A-Level examinations. There is a real sense of anticipation, with some students eagerly reminding me of their final papers, while others have been seeking encouragement ahead of their last exams. We look forward to celebrating their efforts at our upcoming leavers' breakfast and assemblies in the coming weeks.

Although exams are not yet fully complete, I would like to take this opportunity to extend my sincere thanks to all those involved:

- Our exams staff and invigilators for their organisation and dedication
- Our teachers for preparing and supporting students in advance of and throughout the exam period
- Staff who have ensured students receive appropriate access arrangements
- Colleagues who have adapted to room changes and disruptions with flexibility
- Our students, who have shown maturity and respect by maintaining a calm and quiet environment during exams

Finally, thank you to parents and carers of students in Years 11 and 13 for your continued encouragement and support at home. I am sure this has included moments of gentle persistence as well! As always, we ask only that our students give their very best, and I have been impressed by the commitment and resilience they have demonstrated in recent weeks.

Over the past two weeks, students have been learning about Pride Month during tutorial sessions. This has included discussions around inclusion, equality, and the importance of celebrating diversity within our school community and beyond. and encourages allyship and understanding among peers. We are proud to foster an inclusive environment where every student feels valued and supported.

I am also pleased to share that, following a successful pilot and staff training earlier this academic year, we will shortly be launching Hemisphere training for our students, in line with all schools across our Trust.

Hemisphere is an innovative, research-informed programme designed to help schools build a strong culture of belonging, inclusion and mutual respect. It is specifically focussed on building racial literacy and understanding the lived experiences of students from different ethnic backgrounds. The programme uses a combination of storytelling, research and interactive activities and helps participants to recognise and challenge unconscious bias, and to understand how this can impact on students' wellbeing, sense of belonging and, ultimately, their outcomes in school.

I shared with students in this week's Langley Lowdown an exciting range of activities still to come before the summer holidays. There is certainly much to look forward to, including Langley's Got Talent, Sister Act, Summer Arts Festival, Sports Day, Culture Day and Year 12 Work Experience, and much more besides. It promises to be a vibrant and memorable end to the academic year.

After what has been a particularly wet week at times, I am told the weather may finally feel more like summer this weekend. Students have been reminded that due to limited indoor space, we will only operate a wet break or lunch when it is actively raining, rather than when it has rained earlier in the day. We encourage students to come prepared with a coat or umbrella, given the nature of our campus and the need to move between buildings throughout the day.

The LAMDA examination is a wonderful opportunity and extra-curricular achievement. If your child would like to sit an exam, we will discuss the most appropriate grade to choose based on previous singing and acting experience. If you wish to sit a LAMDA exam, there is an additional separate fee paid to the exam board for this.

The classes will start from the beginning of Autumn Term 2026 and will coincide with LPGS' term timetable.
