Dear Families,

Our students continue to impress and to demonstrate excellent habits in lessons and around school. I am naturally hopeful that students will maintain this positive start, since the school year is most certainly a marathon and not a sprint!

In just 5 days students have been awarded an amazing 16,825 positive (P) points for demonstrating our school values of **belonging**, **equality**, **kindness**, **ambition**, **respect** and **determination**. The relatively small number of C points some students have already received this year are, we believe, entirely avoidable since they are a consequence of lateness to school/lessons, uniform infringements or a lack of homework. We maintain that these habits and expectations prepare our students for the world of work and support their academic success and urge students to meet the school's standards and expectations.

I would like to thank those families who were in attendance at our Year 11 and Year 12 Welcome & Information Evenings this week. The parents and carers of Year 12 students had the opportunity to meet with their child's tutors and presentations from pastoral staff, our Careers Team and subject leaders lay the foundations for the year ahead for our young people. Our Year 7 Welcome and Information Evening is taking place next week in school and we will be sharing a recorded presentation to parents/carers of students in Years 10 and 13 at the end of the week.

I expressed my thanks to those families who complete our parent/carer survey towards the end of last academic year and have shared some of the key strengths and areas for development in this weekly newsletter as we look to continually improve the experience for our students and families.

A particular highlight for me this week was teaching my first lesson of the year to a new class of enthusiastic Year 7 German students! An equally enthusiastic teacher enjoyed establishing our LPGS learning routines and introducing students to the benefits of learning a language and sharing some of the quirks of the German language. As I get to know my students and learn new names, the experience left me in awe of the work our teachers do to get to know and teach so many different students in several classes, while also teaching multiple lessons every day.

Looking ahead to next week, our school photographers are in school on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> September and photographs will be taken of our Year 7, 10 and 12 students for our school records. Portraits will be available for order subsequently and we will share further details once proof copies are available after the day.

Finally, the News Shopper reported this week on Department for Education data showing which Bromley secondary schools are the most popular with families and it is naturally really pleasing to see that Langley Park School for Girls is one of the most in demand schools with 209 first choice applications for our 236 places. We will, of course be inviting prospective students and families to our open evening event next month and look forward as staff and students to showcasing our school.


#### **MESSAGES FROM STAFF**


