## Year 10 GCSE Geography Fieldwork – Isle of Dogs

As part of the GCSE Geography course, students are required to undertake two fieldwork investigations. This fieldwork is a compulsory element of the qualification and will be assessed in the Paper 2 examination. We are therefore arranging for our Year 10 geographers to complete their human geography fieldwork by undertaking an urban enquiry in the Isle of Dogs.

Students will complete a transect walk from Mudchute to Canary Wharf, collecting data from 10 different locations to explore how quality of life varies across urban areas and how this affects the local environment. This is a fantastic opportunity for Year 10 students to see real-life geography in action.

The trip will run on two different dates. Please see the table below to identify which day your child will be attending. If they are unsure of their class, they should check their timetable or speak to their geography teacher.

Students should report to the DALO at 8:00am on the morning of their trip for a trip briefing and to register. We will then walk to Eden Park station and travel by train and DLR to Mudchute. We aim to return to Eden Park Station at approximately 3:00pm. Students will be expected to make their own way home from Eden Park station, although they may return to school with staff if they prefer.

If your child intends to get off the train earlier than Eden Park, this must be indicated on the EVOLVE form in the appropriate section. Unfortunately, we are unable to accept text messages from parents on the day.

Students are expected to wear full school uniform, but they may wear trainers due to the amount of walking involved. A packed lunch should be brought, though there may be limited opportunities to purchase light refreshments. Please ensure any spending money is limited to a maximum of £10. If your child is in receipt of free school meals, a packed lunch will be available for them to collect on the morning of their trip.

We advise students to bring a waterproof coat and umbrella in case of poor weather. If students bring valuables, such as mobile phones, they do so at their own risk.

There is no associated cost for this trip. Parents/carers will receive a consent/medical form via EVOLVE, which must be completed by the **16<sup>th</sup> June**.

We expect all students to uphold the highest standards of behaviour throughout the trip, as they are representing the school at all times. Any issues may result in follow-up actions once we return to school.

Please note that any student may be removed from the trip should their behaviour be a cause for concern in school.
