## Year 11 – GCSE Photography Trip – 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2026

I am delighted to offer your child a place on the Year 11 Photography trip to The Photographers Gallery in Central London. The trip has been arranged for your child's GCSE photography group so they can be inspired by current Photography exhibits at the gallery and take photographs of their surroundings to build on their photographic knowledge. There is no cost to this trip and we have applied for free travel from TfL however students should bring a topped up travel card with enough funds for the return journey in the event they are not travelling home with staff and getting off at Eden Park Station.

The visit will take place on Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> February. All students should register in the Visual Arts foyer area at 9:05am so that we are ready to leave at 9:30am. We will then walk to Eden Park station and travel to Oxford Circus.

From Oxford Circus, we will walk to the Photographers Gallery and have time to take photographs of the buildings, structures and other things that may inspire their 'FOUND' projects. Following this we will all visit the current exhibitions.

We will return to school using the same route and intend to be back at school at 3:30pm. If students wish to get off at a different station to Eden Park on the return journey, please request this on the consent form via Evolve.

All pupils must wear school uniform on the day but are allowed to wear trainers. Students should also bring a packed lunch. If students are in receipt of free school meals, they can collect a packed lunch from the canteen at the start of the day. We will be taking the school DSLR cameras on the trip and they will also be allowed to take photographs on their personal cameras or phones. There will not be many opportunities for the students to spend money so we recommend they bring no more than £10.

You will shortly receive an email from our trip system, Evolve, asking for consent for the trip. Please complete by Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> January including whether you give permission for your child to get off at a different station on the Eden Park Line. Please note, if we do not receive consent for this trip then your child will not be able to attend.

Please note that any student may be removed from this trip should their behaviour be a cause for concern in school.
