Between each assessment, students will attend lessons as normal.

These assessments are designed to be a robust review of the content covered thus far and will allow for a meaningful check on progress. To aid students' revision, subject teachers have created Revision Schedules. These are available via [Firefly](#) and we advise that students rate each topic using **Red** (knowledge yet to be secure), **Amber** (learning somewhat secure) and **Green** (learning secure). From this, they will be able to prioritise their revision.

You can help your child by ensuring they have organised their revision, preferably with a study timetable and that they have a quiet place to work without distractions, including from social media platforms. Healthy routines, including sleep and a healthy diet, are also crucial to their ability to sustain focus throughout the week.
