Between each assessment, students will attend lessons as normal.

These assessments are designed to be a robust review of the content covered thus far and will allow for a meaningful check on progress. To aid students' revision, subject teachers have created Revision Schedules. These are available via Firefly and we advise that students rate each topic using Red (knowledge yet to be secure), Amber (learning somewhat secure) and Green (learning secure). From this, they will be able to prioritise their revision.

You can help your child by ensuring they have organised their revision, preferably with a study timetable and that they have a quiet place to work without distractions, including from social media platforms. Healthy routines, including sleep and a healthy diet, are also crucial to their ability to sustain focus throughout the week.
