Re: Year 9 Assessment Weeks: 8th - 19th December

We are writing to inform you about the upcoming Key Stage 3 (KS3) Assessment Weeks, scheduled to take place between **Monday 8th December and Friday 19th December**. These assessments will occur during normal lesson times and are designed to provide valuable insights into your child's progress across their subjects.

Students will be provided with a blank revision timetable during form time to populate with the topics outlined below. Students are reminded to block out time for clubs and activities to ensure a healthy balance between study and recreation.

In addition, they will also attend an assembly on the following themes:

Revision methods

- Finding a method that works well for your child, such as flash cards, mind maps, peer teaching etc.

Healthy habits

- Sleeping, eating, and screentime habits were looked at, along with their advantages and disadvantages.

This structured approach is intended to help students take ownership of their learning and develop effective revision strategies. We encourage you to discuss the timetable with your child and support them in creating a manageable revision schedule at home.
